

#### **DBS Approved ID Documents list and**

#### Evidence checking Routes to verify a DBS applicant's Identity.

#### Route 1 - must always wherever possible go down this route

The applicant must be able to show:

- x1 document from Group 1 list (below),
- x2 further documents from either Group 1, or Group 2a or 2b (below).

Note: At least one of the documents must show the applicant's current address.

## Route 2 – only if the applicant cannot produce a Group 1 Id document

If the applicant doesn't have any of the documents in Group 1, then they must be able to show:

- x1 document from Group 2a
- x2 further documents from either Group 2a or 2b
- x1 External ID check against the living history footprint (a **PASS** result)

We are setup to process an External ID check for the applicant. We need the applicant to sign a consent form and return back to us, in order to continue. There is a £15 charge to process this check.

## Route 3 – If the applicant has failed the ID check confirmation.

Route 3 can only be used if it's impossible to process the application through Routes 1 or 2.

For Route 3, the applicant must be able to show:

- x1 Birth certificate issued after the time of birth (UK and Channel Islands only)
- x1 other document from Group 2a
- x3 further documents from Group 2a or 2b

At least one of the documents must show the applicant's current address. If the applicant can't provide these documents they may need to be fingerprinted.

#### If you cannot proceed to validate the Identity using Route 1 – 3 above:

The applicant needs to fill out a paper DBS application and on the back where it asks if you have confirmed the applicant's identity (W59 question), must be marked "NO".

Once we have sent the application to the DBS, the applicant will then be sent a request to have their fingerprints taken at their local police station, before the application can continue.
